Model

JP171SW and JP271SW

Finish

Silver-plated or German grade brass lacquer.

Body

Both cornets bodies are made of brass. The Silverplated model produces a distinctive brighter sound.

Features

The shape of the leadpipe on the cornet has been designed by Dr Richard Smith of Smith Watkins. Dr Smith is world renowned for his expertise with leadpipes and acoustics. This leadpipe is exclusive to these cornets.

The 171SW model features mobile first and third valve slides and a third water key. The cornet is medium bore making it ideal for student players to get a fuller sound. Both models come with a lyre box, for those 'marching moments'.

Accessories and maintenance

The cornet is supplied with a JP603 mouthpiece, an all round starter mouthpiece, neither too deep nor too shallow. Many players will customise their instrument with their own choice of mouthpiece, which adheres to their specific playing requirements.

Case

The cornet case is lightweight and strong. It comes with backpack straps, shoulder straps and carrying handles for convenience and security. There is an internal accessory section and external pocket for sheet music.
